

We plan to re-open on 15th June (subject to government guidelines) and we are currently open for online delivery and click and collect orders only.

We will be following government guidelines and therefore are making changes to our premises and adding further options in the following way:

- A one way system creating safe entry and exit
- The option for parents and student at the entrance to use hand sanitiser
- The creation of serving bays to allow social distancing
- The restriction of allowing 1 parent, 1 student to enter the premises. (if there is an obvious reason for more than 1 parent or student then this will be catered for)
- As numbers entering our premises at any one time will be restricted, there will have to be a queuing system at peak times outside our shop
- **To provide a click and collect service where customer buys online & collects** (We will have a separate queue for this)
- It will be **essential** to encourage existing parents to use the click and collect service to reduce numbers that will attend our premises, especially the nearer we get to back to school in September
- We are in the process of improving our size guides on the website
- We have a new appointment system which can be booked through our website. **Please encourage your parents to book an appointment as early as possible**
- We will be extending our opening hours as we progress towards the back to school season
- There will be **no** opportunity to use any of our fitting rooms
- Items that are returned to us will be quarantined or steam cleaned until they are considered safe to be re sold

Bower Park Academy – Uniform Expectations

We insist on the following simple, but smart, uniform for all students at the academy and rely on parents for their full support. If there are any doubts or queries with regard to our uniform policy, please contact us prior to purchasing new clothing/equipment etc.

There is a scheme of financial assistance for the purchase of children's academy clothing. If you think you qualify or if you experience any difficulty with providing the uniform for your child, please contact the academy directly. All such enquiries are dealt with sympathetically and in the strictest confidence.

- PE kit must only be worn for PE/dance lessons or for a sporting event
- 'Hoodies', sweatshirts or non-academy jumpers are not allowed in the Academy. They must not be worn instead of a coat or for PE. If seen these will be confiscated
- Extreme dress is not permitted at any time including visible coloured undergarments
- Piercings are not allowed at academy. This includes ear, tongue, eyebrow, nose, lip and facial. Students will be required to remove the facial jewellery
- Hair bands or slides must be plain black or brown, thin hair bands only with no adornments
- Make-up must not be worn in KS3; this includes foundation and fake tan, black eyeliner, eye shadow, mascara, fake eyelashes and lipstick
- Discreet make-up may be worn for Years 10 & 11 - students wearing excessive make up will be required to remove it
- No coloured nail varnish or false nails (e.g. gels, acrylic nails)
- Nails must be natural.
